



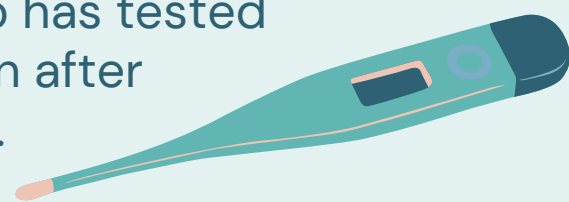
COVID-19 Events Guidelines

These guidelines are based on the best-known public health practices and they are formulated in combination of CDC guidelines and NYS laws:

Screening

Farm employees who are not feeling well will be ordered to self-quarantine. We encourage all of our members and guests to enforce the same standards who are in the same condition.

Any Farm employee or member who has tested positive for COVID19 may only return after completing a 14-day self quarantine.



Cleaning Methods

We are using Electrostatic spraying technology with TABS (EPA registered) disinfectants, sanitizers, bleach alternatives, and Prot Electrostatic Sprayers.

These sprayers have an effectiveness against COVID-19 on hard, non porous surfaces.



Food and Drink

No open self-serve buffet style food shall be allowed during any event. All food and drink consumption must be in its individual serving given to each guest.

All plates, cups and utensils must be disposed immediately after usage.



Contact Tracing

If a guest tests positive for COVID-19 within the following 14 days of the event, The Farm should be notified immediately, including notification of potential contacts, such as other event guests who had close contact with the individual.

The Farm cannot be held responsible for the health of those who use the space or potentially become ill thereafter.

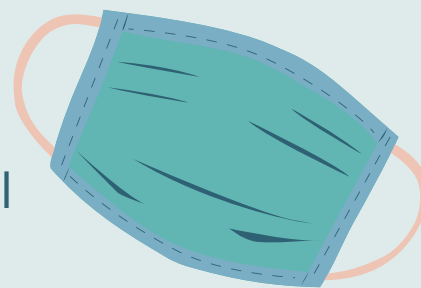


Protective Equipment and Supplies

We ask all of our guests to wear protective face covering in all event venues and common areas and maintain at least 6 feet of distance from everyone.

All common areas will have hand sanitizer stations, including paper towels, and alcohol based hand sanitizer.

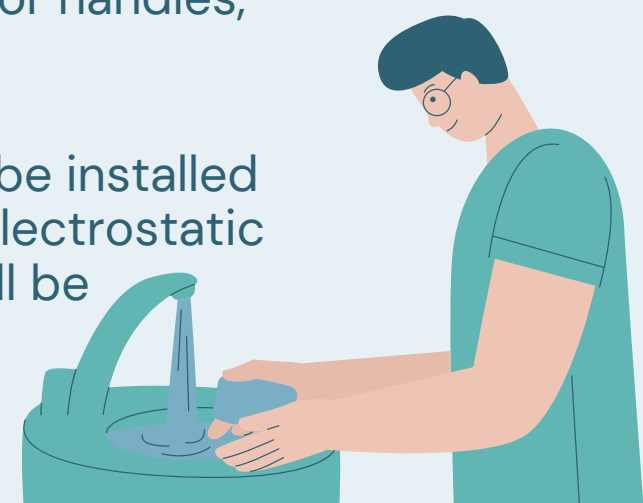
All guests and Farm personnel must sanitize hands upon entering Farm locations.



Cleaning Policies

All frequently touched surfaces along with our standard cleaning process will be included in the daily cleaning checklist, i.e. door handles, tabletops, sinks and faucets.

HVAC higher efficiency filters will be installed to stop the spread of COVID-19. Electrostatic cleaning of ventilation systems will be periodically performed.



Conference Rooms and Event Venues

Ensure 6 ft. distance in common areas, i.e. bathrooms areas, hallways. We will have floor stickers installed for directing walkway traffic within all of the common areas. Elevators shall be occupied by only one individual at a time.

We advise that all members and guests avoid behaviors that increase the chance of any contamination. (i.e such as sharing food, not abiding by density requirements)

All visitors shall enter their name and email contact information in the check-in system provided by The Farm.



We're closely following up with the continuously changing Federal / State / CDC / OSHA guidelines and will keep you updated throughout the process.
